Agenda Item #1. Trini started the meeting, asked that everyone to turn off their cell phones, and to step outside if they get a phone call. He then asked for a moment of silence. INFO.

Agenda Item #2. Secretary's Report: The August minutes were in the newsletter. Robert (as always) made a motion to accept. Seconded. Passed. INFO.

Agenda Item #3. Treasurer's Report: Arthur reported our checking account bank balance. INFO.

Agenda Item #4. Meeting Sponsor: ABPA-SA sponsored the meeting. INFO.

Agenda Item #5. Meal: ABPA-SA sponsored the meal from Jason's Deli, your choice of roast beef, ham, and turkey croissant sandwiches, chips, a pickle, and a cookie. Art donated and had the water and soda delivered for the meeting. Please e-mail Art before 5 PM on Monday. The order is input at 5 PM. If you do not order – you will only get one if there is a no show. INFO.

Agenda Item #6. Raffle: ABPA-SA provided \$50 cash for a \$2 raffle ticket. INFO.

Agenda Item #7. Training: Fred will provide the training on Repair or Replace. INFO.

Agenda Item #8. SAWS: Dan Crowley, the Director of Governmental Relations for SAWS, introduced the new SAWS Backflow Section supervisor, Mark Schnur with 20 years at SAWS with extensive past experience. A new BPAT licensee was introduced: Rudy Laura – just passed the BPAT exam. No questions. INFO.

Agenda Item #9. TCEQ: Fred said that there is an article on ethics on the TCEQ website. There is no longer a 30-day extension for license expiration. If you go past your expiration date without required CEUs, a re-exam is now required. Many years ago, TCEQ extended the CEU deadline because of a fire in East Texas. Now, if your license expires, you'll take hands on and written. Fred said to look up HB 1237 for more information. He said that TCEQ will require all, with a water license, to take 4 hours of CEUs dedicated to ethics. TCEQ is now ensuring that the backflow class instructors are teaching need-to-know criteria, and are on the same page. INFO.

Agenda Item #10. COSA Plumbing Inspections: Mike Morales, Chief Plumbing Inspector, said that for new backflow inspections, SAWS wants blue T&M receipt. Only thing SAWS is taking is the T&M form that TCEQ gave them. TCEQ did not approve of receipt. Part of the issue is a signature. COSA needs proof that it was done. Jeff S. said that a written signature is against all that the electronic T&M wants to eliminate. There was no solution at this time. Mike, Jeff, and others to look for solution, assuring TCEQ requirements are met. OPEN.

Agenda Item #11. Gauge Testing: Carl said that BAVCO will test your gauge for free. No appointment is necessary if you want BAVCO to test the gauge. However, call BAVCO to ensure James is there. Tell them who you are with ABPA-SA Chapter, fill out the gauge form and if they have time, they will test it then or you can leave it and they will call you when it is done. If it needs to be repaired, you can take it to whoever you want or you can leave it and they will fix it, but there will charge you. INFO.

Agenda Item #12. Newsletter: Troy is our new chapter newsletter editor, replacing Bill Hamrick. Troy asked how many have read the newsletter on line. He then distributed printed copies. Troy said he needs feedback to better serve the chapter on what's presented in the monthly publication. He asked for Backflow Nightmare submissions. The best submission receives a \$200 cash prize. Must be submitted before our November meeting. INFO.

Agenda Item #13. Chapter Elections: Jeff Stricker will be our new chapter President replacing Trini who is limited to a "two-year term." Thank you, Trini, for the last two years. Arthur volunteered to remain as Treasure and Greg as Secretary (16 years and counting). However, we need a volunteer for Vice President. If no one volunteers, a volunteer will be named. Joe Young, our Program Director, is still in the hospital and is doing well. OPEN.

Agenda Item #14. November Raffle: Carl said that Bill Hamrick had a new gauge and gauge case, that will be donated to the November raffle. INFO.

Agenda Item #15. Hands-On Training: Fred said that the training is scheduled for September 16, 2025 (Tuesday). Five meetings per year, for three years' attendance qualify for the free 8-hour TCEQ required hands-on training. This is for those, whose BPAT expires next year. It is dependent on the number of meeting CEUs earned. He has the sign-up sheet. Bring TCEQ CEU print out of your meetings to qualify. This will be a "bump" year as, of the three-year cycle, this is the largest. INFO.

Agenda Item #16. Training: Type of Repair kit cost comparison. A lot of money goes into a Replacement kit. Amount charged can't always be controlled. Dishonesty can. A backflow tester's job is not to find all assemblies. That would be a Customer Service Inspector's job. Liabilities could be involved if a backflow tester missed an assembly. A backflow tester does NIIO, Notify, Identify, Inspect, Observe. Outside of the service testing the assembly, water purveyor should be involved. Sometimes office person orders parts, a lapse in communication can be problem. Several Repair options were explained, with examples of each. Importance of reputable parts supply house discussed, there are several across the country.

Prices – old prices: \$4.30 for a Conbraco rubber kit. A replacement includes springs and all parts with is much more expensive - and often not needed. Testing nightmares - 5 item examples were given. Failure rates were discussed, with new installs being among the highest, due to debris. Lines appropriately flushed on new installs, extremely important. Need to put maintenance performed on T&M. Document what's needed on T&M. One nightmare, customer changed r/p #1 shut off valve on new install - found out later 'office person' made mis-diagnosis. Customer education: everyone from tester to water purveyor representative is critical. The importance of a defensible backflow program, and its necessity discussed.

Should an assembly be disassembled when replaced?. Don't know if backflow situation occurred. Gave examples. Water hammer – damaged checks, have seen lots of examples – air in the line, quick closing valves can be an issue. Has seen checks removed by customer, sometimes after assembly had been installed backward. Problems with particular models was discussed. Who's at fault with 'just replace it'. Protection for the customer: important. Should there be a requirement for assembly to be inspected internally at specific times. There have been several presentations on this topic at national conferences going back 30+ years.

Adjournment. Adjourn the meeting at 8:09 PM for the raffle.

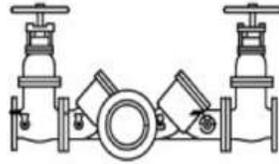


